

Code of Ethics (OAC 4733-35 abridged)

In order to safeguard the life, health, property and welfare of the public and the state of Ohio, to maintain integrity and high standards of skills and practice in the professions of engineering, I shall:

Act with complete integrity as a faithful agent, be honest and impartial, and serve the public, client and employer with devotion.

Protect the safety, health and welfare of the public in the performance of professional duties.

Undertake to perform assignments only when, or with consulting support, qualified by training and experience in the specific technical fields involved.

Be completely objective in any professional report, statement or testimony and include all relevant and pertinent information.

Express an opinion as a technical expert only when it is founded upon adequate knowledge of the facts, technical competence in the subject matter, and upon honest conviction.
