SEAO will soon add Twitter to our means of communication, in addition to the more traditional methods.

So what is Twitter and why should SEAO members take interest?

Briefly, Twitter is a communication network that allows people and organizations to send and receive brief messages, frequently called “tweets”. These messages are limited in length, 140 characters, and may be sent and received over the internet or with cell phones. Breaking news headlines, links to online stories, comments questions and replies to any of these can be sent and received. Unlike email which may only be seen by the recipients, most tweets may be viewed by anyone which is one of the medium’s advantages, users can cast their message to an unlimited audience.

Why does it mean to follow someone?

When a Twitter user follows someone, he or she is agreeing to directly receive messages from that person. This is similar to subscribing to a newsletter.

How I need to get started?
